## Gatsby 6- Work Experience

- On-site programme
- 3 half terms of weekly internal work experience
- 3 half terms of external work experience (KS34 only)
- External employment

## Gatsby 7- FE & Post 16 Provision

- Visit alternative provision
- 1 day a week at college
- Offered college place Post 16

## Gatsby 8- Personal Guidance

- 1:1 careers interview
- Access Careers Pilot
- Preparation for Adulthood / Upwards and Onwards targets
- EHCP support where needed
